

Armoury Policy and Charges 2026/27



Keeping your equipment in the best condition it can be in is vital to fencing. Not only will it keep you and your opponent safe, but will help you to score more points, more consistently.

We recommend you learn the basics of fixing your own equipment yourself and regularly clean and check your equipment, especially before events. If you require any equipment fixing, please see the policy below and the table of charges.

- Equipment that needs repairing should be handed into one of the coaches on your training night.
- Your equipment will not be accepted for repair if it is not named.
- Your equipment will not be accepted for repair if the repair itself would render the equipment unsafe to use.
- Certain repairs cannot be performed by Luso International Fencing and will need to be sent to the original supplier or third party.
- Luso International Fencing has an agreement with AllstarUK fencing and as such has a ready supply of parts for Allstar equipment. If you use any other brand there may be a delay in sourcing the required parts.
- Please allow 1 week to perform most repairs. If the timeframe for this is likely to be longer, you will be informed.
- Certain repairs, e.g. blade straightening, can result in the complete failure and/or destruction of the item being repaired. Luso International Fencing and its armourers and coaches cannot be held liable for these particular damages. You will be informed if the repair risks the destruction of your equipment.
- Payment for repairs is to be made before the repair begins. Any additional costs will be communicated directly to you before work is completed and these can be paid upon receipt of your equipment.
- Prices below are for the standard repair and parts of Allstar Equipment. The price may vary to fix other brands.
- Payments up to £10 to be made in cash when handing in equipment for repair.
- Payments over £10 can be made in cash or by card when handing equipment in for repair.
